
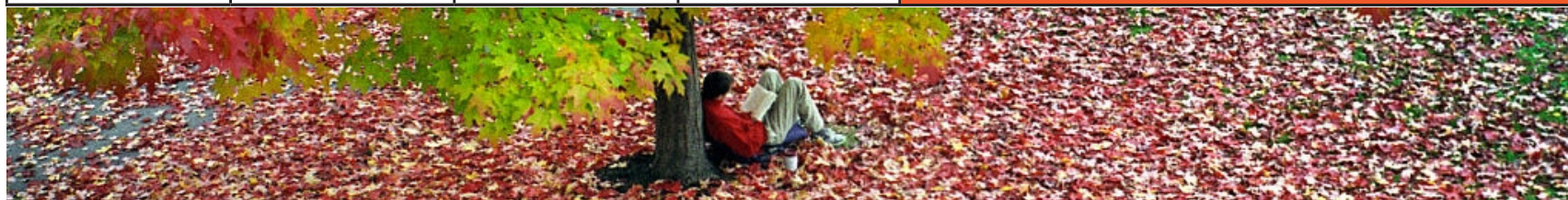

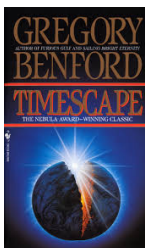

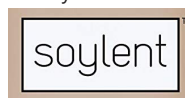

Mystery Mavens meet the fourth Tuesday of every month. This month's book is **THE DRY** by Jane Harper.

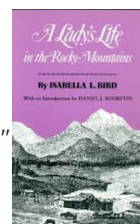

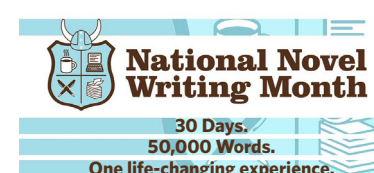
