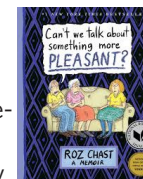

The series continues with the third book discussion of MEDICINE WALK by Richard Wagamese on November 12.

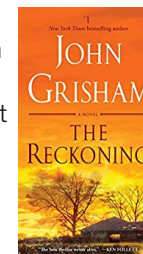
