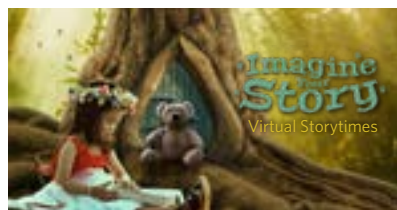
### Summer Reading Program Goals and Prizes
