- ♦ **COMPUTER ART:** Computer-generated art should be original, created entirely with a computer, and no larger than 11"x17".

- ♦ **SHORT STORIES** should be no longer than 8 pages written legibly in ink or 4 pages typed and double-spaced.
- ♦ **DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON YOUR ENTRY.** Your name should appear only on this cover sheet. Entries should be returned — WITH this cover sheet — to one of Hutchinson Public Library's circulation desks.
- ♦ Separate cover sheets are needed for each entry. While you may enter more than one category and more than one piece in the same category, you can only win one prize overall. Prizes of \$30 for 1st place, \$20 for 2nd place, and \$10 for 3rd place will be awarded for each format in each age group.
- ♦ **DEADLINE** for entries is 9pm on March 31, 2008. Winners will be announced after April 6th.
